

HOW TO PLAY INTERSECTIONS TRIV-INGO

Print (or order printed cards) and distribute one TRIV-INGO card to each guest, along with a way to mark them (penny, button, pen). Print one copy of the TRIV-INGO terms for yourself.

To play, read off a term. Don't read the description right now – keep the pace light and fun. As you call out terms, guests will mark their cards. Once someone has TRIV-INGO (5 in a row in any direction), have them read their squares back to you and, as they do, share the description. (For example, 2005 – that was the year that Project 1.27 was founded.)

Play as many rounds as you like! People can reuse their cards.

Don't worry if more than one person has TRIV-INGO at the same time –we'll send you more prizes.

SAMPLE SCRIPT:

Let's Play Project 1.27 TRIV-INGO!

I will give you a term that is associated with Project 1.27 and kids in foster care. If you have it anywhere on your card, mark it. The first person to have 5 squares in a row marked shouts TRIV-INGO. There are prizes!

TRIV-INGO TERMS

8: Average age of a child in foster care. Anyone know an 8-year-old? Imagine if that child came into foster care. Wouldn't you want a well-prepared, well-supported, loving family ready to offer him/her a safe place to call home.

10%: The More Than Enough goal for percentage of churches in every county in the US to be engaged in foster care by 2025. This is more than enough to meet the needs of all children in foster care.

13: Number of organizations in the 1.27 National Network. (Arizona, D.C., Louisiana, Florida, Minnesota, Virginia, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, California, Ohio, Georgia and Texas). 4 more in the works this year!

15: Average number of people on one child's foster care team. Project 1.27 families receive training on how to work with this team to help children in their care heal, catch up developmentally and build healthy, trusting relationships.

200: Average number of children served in Colorado annually.

370: Number of churches the 1.27 National Network expects to engage this year.

450: Number of Project 1.27 Colorado adoptions to date.

2005: Founding date. Project 1.27 has 15 years of experience in preparing and supporting exceptional foster and adoptive families.

3,850: Number of kids the 1.27 National Network expects to serve this year.

100,000+: Number of US children waiting for adoption! A number the 1.27 National Network works to bring down to 0.

423,000: Number of children in US Foster Care. A huge opportunity to bring hope to children who have experienced great heartache.

1.800.CO4KIDS: State child abuse reporting hotline for Colorado—every state has one. Do you know yours? Anonymous and vital to keeping children safe.

ABUSE & NEGLECT: The primary reasons that children enter the foster care system.

AGE OUT: When a child leaves foster care with no permanent family. Without family support, there is little chance of continuing their education and a large percentage become homeless or incarcerated. Many girls become pregnant before 21 and the cycle continues. Over 20,000 teens age-out of foster care every year. Tonight, we have an opportunity to stop this cycle!

CARE PORTAL: An online platform that connects and fulfills the needs of foster, adoptive, kinship and at-risk children through local churches. Many 1.27 National Network organizations have launched Care Portal in their community.

DEVELOPMENTAL DELAYS: Condition experienced by children who have not had their basic needs met consistently. Project 1.27 families are prepared to support children in overcoming these delays. There is something satisfying about seeing a child develop grade-level and higher reading skills, conquer speech delays or successfully kick the soccer ball across the field for the first time.

DIVERSITY: Project 1.27 families are diverse and welcome children from varied cultural, ethnic, religious, or social backgrounds. This provides a rich life experience for all involved. Project 1.27 training helps prepare families for the joys and challenges of this experience.

FACT: Foster Adoption Core Training—the state-mandated certification materials for foster parents and part of Project 1.27's 30 hours of pre-certification training.

FAMILY VISITS: Scheduled, usually supervised, interactions with the child and their parents. Foster parents often provide transportation to and from these visits, encouraging and supporting family reunification.

FOSTER FRIENDLY CHURCH: Churches where foster, adoptive and kinship families are well-supported, and the congregation is prepared to care for children who have experienced trauma, grief and loss.

HOTEL ROOMS/OFFICES: Where kids in foster care stay when no family is available.

INTERSECTIONS: Where heartache meets hope. Tonight, I want to share how you can offer hope to a child in foster care.

JAMES 1.27: Founding verse. “Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this – that we look after orphans in their distress...” NIV

KINSHIP CARE: Kinship care is provided by relatives or close family friends. Project 1.27 trains and support kinship providers.

MONTHLY DONORS: Donors who commit to contributing a designated amount each month. Monthly donors are a sustaining base for Project 1.27’s efforts to recruit and support families for kids in foster care.

MISSION: The mission of Project 1.27 is to inspire, recruit and resource churches and families to foster and adopt the kids in their own backyard.

PASTOR ROBERT: Pastor of Colorado Community Church and adoptive dad whose vision inspired the founding of Project 1.27.

PCORE: The biblically based training segment developed by Project 1.27 designed to help Christian families bring hope and healing to children in foster care.

REUNIFICATION: God designed family as the perfect environment for child development. When parents take the opportunity to change, children can return home safely. Reunification is the redemption of a family.


TRAUMA-INFORMED: Evidence-based, attachment-focused parenting resources that bring hope and healing for kids. Every Project 1.27 is equipped with trauma-informed parenting tools and resources.

TREATMENT PLAN: Court-ordered plan a parent must complete to regain custody of their child. Project 1.27 families encourage and support parents completing this plan and moving towards reunification.

SUPPORT TEAM: Family and friends committed to supporting a foster family. Project 1.27 requires every family to bring at least 4 people to 4 hours of support team training. Some families bring 20+. This is one reason Project 1.27 has a low rate of children disrupting from their foster placement and high rate of foster parents who never give up.

VISION: The vision of Project 1.27 is a family waiting for every child. We believe no kid should ever have to wait for a foster or adoptive family.
